11TH NATIONAL CONVENTION ON STATISTICS

1. The National Statistical Coordination Board (NSCB) through the Philippine Statistics System (PSS) will hold its 11th National Convention on Statistics (NCS) on October 4-5, 2010 at the EDSA Shangri-la Hotel in Mandaluyong City. This convention coincides with the opening of the 21st National Statistics Month celebration in October.

2. The objectives of the activity are to:


- a. provide the participants a forum for exchanging ideas and experiences in the field of statistics, and for discussing recent statistical developments and prevailing issues and problems of the PSS; and
- b. elicit the cooperation and support of statisticians and professionals in related fields from the government, academe, and private sector towards a more responsive statistical system.

3. The convention will bring together approximately 1,000 statisticians, researchers, and applied scientists from all over the country to share, learn and improve knowledge and skills in the field of statistics and its applications to other related fields.

4. In this connection, all concerned are enjoined to participate in the said convention. A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) will be charged each participant from the government sector, and Six Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP6,500.00) each participant from the private sector. The registration fee shall cover attendance in all sessions, lunch, snacks for two (2) days, convention kit including a complete set of the papers in CD-ROM.
