SUBJECT : **PARTICIPATION IN THE 11TH NATIONAL CONVENTION ON STATISTICS**

Date : July 7, 2010

The Philippine Statistical System (PSS) spearheaded by the National Statistical Coordination Board (NSCB) will hold the 11th National Convention on Statistics (NCS) on Oct. 4-5, 2010 at the EDSA Shang-ri-la Hotel in Mandaluyong City. The convention coincides with the opening of the 21st National Statistics Month celebration in October.

The NCS has the following two-fold objectives to wit:

- a. to provide a forum for exchanging ideas and experiences in the field of statistics, and for discussing recent statistical developments and prevailing issues and problems of the PSS; and
- b. to elicit the cooperation and support of statisticians and professionals in related fields from the government, academe, and private sector towards a more responsive statistical system.

The Convention will bring together some 1,000 statisticians, researchers, and applied scientists from all over the country to share, learn and improve knowledge and skills in the field of statistics and its applications and other related fields.

In this connection, all concerned are enjoined to participate in the said convention. A Convention fee of P5,000.00 entitles each participant to attend all sessions for the whole duration, lunch/snacks for two days, including a complete set of the papers in CD-ROM.
