BIR Region 1's Tax Collection Rose by 37 percent in 2005

The total collections of the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) Regional Office I reached PhP 4.416 million in 2005, an increase of 36.8 percent from the PhP 3.227 million total collections in 2004. Likewise, the amount surpassed the 2005 target collection, amounting to PhP 3.519 million, by 25.5 percent.

The bulk of the collection came from Pangasinan which posted PhP 2.692 million collections or 61.0 percent of the total regional collections in 2005. Pangasinan is composed of three Revenue District Offices (RDOs), namely: RDO IV-Calasiao, Pangasinan, RDO V-Alaminos City and RDO VI-Urdaneta City. Among these RDOs, Alaminos City accounted the biggest share at 44.0 percent of the province's total collections

By type of tax, taxes on income contributed PhP 3.168 million or 71.7 percent of the total collections while Value Added Taxes (VAT) amounted to PhP 0.816 million representing 18.5 percent.
